In accordance with WIA sec 101(13); sec 129 (c)(5)(H) and 20 CFR §664.200 and §664.210:


Definitions and eligibility requirements regarding the “requires additional assistance to complete an educational program or to secure and hold employment” criterion of §664.200(c)(6) may be established at the State or local level:

For those individuals who meet the minimum income eligibility requirements, the “sixth” youth criteria for the Little Rock Workforce Investment Area will be defined as:


An individual who requires additional assistance to complete an educational program or to secure and hold employment because of such barriers as environmental, physical, mental, social, legal, psychological, and individual barriers not previously mentioned, as determined by an Assessment Counselor or Case Worker.

For those individuals who do meet the minimum income eligibility requirements, the “sixth” youth criteria for the Little Rock Workforce Investment Area will be defined as:

An individual that faces serious barriers: Individuals who require additional assistance to complete an educational program or to secure and hold employment because of such barriers as environmental, physical, mental, social, legal, psychological, and individual barriers not previously mentioned, as determined by an Assessment Counselor or Case Worker.
